# THE PARIS AGREEMENT IS NON RE NEGOTIABLE PRESIDENT MACRON DECLARED

#### AFTER USA WITHDRAWAL FROM COP21 ACCORD

**USPA NEWS -** President Trump announced Thursday that he will withdraw the United States from participation in the Paris climate accord, weakening global efforts to combat climate change. French President Emmanuel Macron was the first to react to this decision that he "respects but considers a mistake for the planet and the world" during a declaration at the Elysee at 11 pm.

He added that "we will not renegotiate a less ambitious agreement on the Paris Climate Agreement". President Macron took the opportunity to invite "Researchers, experts and citizens committed to climate change to come to work in France" This hand extended of France goes against the American "pretext" of the loss of jobs that would generate by its constraints, the Paris Agreement on Climate, according to the estimates of the White House.
