The quays are lined with traditional Arab dhows, traditional craft and a ballad is required by "Abra" (water taxi) to cross from one bank to another. Then go to Bastakiya Heritage Village, the picturesque district where traditional houses Dubaiotes restored, once were ventilated by wind towers (which still exist). We see here in Deira a glimpse of what life in Dubai 50 years ago. As for the beautiful art and craft shops reminiscent of Bedouin life of its inhabitants, before the discovery of oil. The historical heart, Shindagha, can be admired in the old residence of Sheikh Saeed, which was erected in the 19th century and houses a magnificent collection of photographs of yesteryear. Then, the Heritage Museum Dubai, inside Fahidi Fort, the visitor delves into the past of the city Luxurious hotels in Dubai parade on the promenade by the sea until Maktoum Bridge and Dubai Creek Golf Course. Meandering towards the Persian Gulf, the ballad crosses the ledge that leads to the development of offshore Palm Deira. That's another symbolic of the Palms sacred trees of the Desert.

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
